Galatians 6:1-10

1. Read Galatians 6:1-5. What should be our response to another Christian who is “caught in a sin”? What do we often do instead?

2. What warning does Paul give in verse 3? How can we avoid a spirit of self-righteousness or conceit? Are there legitimate grounds for feeling good about one’s self? (v. 4)

3. Verses 2 and 5 seem to contradict each other. How would you reconcile these verses?

4. What kinds of “burdens” do others have? How can we help carry them?

5. What are some practical reasons for Paul’s command in verse 6?

6. Read Galatians 6:7-10. According to verse 7, “God cannot be mocked.” What does it mean to mock God?

7. What principle of sowing and reaping is found in verses 7-8? How might you “sow to the Spirit” this week?

8. Why do we become “weary in doing good”? How can we prevent it?

9. What is the Christian’s responsibility toward other people? Where might you have an opportunity this week to fulfill that responsibility?
