Lesson 19  
Luke 10:1-24

1. Read Luke 10:1-16. As Chapter 10 begins, whom does Jesus send and to whom does he send them? What was their *primary* task? (v. 9)
  
2. What is the first thing he told them to do? What warning does he give them? What restrictions does he put on them? Why? (vv. 2-4)
  
3. What further instructions did he give them? (vv. 5-9)
  
4. What were they to declare publicly to the towns that rejected them? (vv. 10-12)
  
5. What fate awaits those that reject his offer of salvation? (vv. 13-16)
  
6. Read Luke 10:17-20. What was the source of the disciples' joy? Why does that seem in contrast to the requirements and nature of their ministry? What is the greatest and most fundamental reason for the rejoicing of any disciple?
  
7. Read Luke 10:21, 2 Peter 3:9, and 1 Cor. 1:26-31. Why is Jesus full of joy and praising God? Who are the "wise and learned" and the "little children?" Is God found through human wisdom?
  
8. Read Luke 10:22-24. What unique relationship does Jesus have with the Father? Why do any of us "know" God? What have we seen and heard that the prophets and kings had not?
  
9. What was encouraging to you in this lesson regarding your calling as one of Christ's ambassadors? (2 Cor. 5:11-21)
