Luke 3:1-37

Read Luke 3:1-20 to get the story of John the Baptist. Then go back and answer the questions according to the verses that are referenced.

1. When did John begin his ministry? Why? Luke named seven different prominent men. Why did he include so many details? (Luke 3:1-2)
  
2. What was John preaching? For what purpose? (Luke 3:3, Matt 3:1-3)
  
3. According to the prophecy of Isaiah, what was John’s ministry? For what purpose? How did he “prepare the way for the Lord”? (Luke 3:4-6)
  
4. For what did John rebuke the crowds? Of what did he warn them? (Luke 3:7-9)
  
5. What three examples of true repentance did John give to those who asked? (Luke 3:10-14)
  
6. What distinctions did John make between himself and Jesus Christ? (Luke 3:15-18)
  
7. What happened to John? (vv. 19-20) List several ways that John is a good example for all who want to share the gospel of Christ.
  
8. Read Luke 3:21-37 and Matt. 3:13-17. Why did Jesus, who was without sin, need to be baptized by John?
  
9. Why do you think Luke included the genealogy of Jesus at this point? In what two major ways does the genealogy given in Matthew 1:1-17 differ? What could be a possible explanation?
