Luke 9:1-17

1. Read Luke 9:1-9. Verse 1 says Jesus gave his disciples both power and authority. What is the difference? Why did they need both?
2. What was their primary task? Why were they given the ability to do miracles?
3. Why did Jesus limit what they could take with them? Can you think of any reason why they were to stay at the first house that offered them hospitality and not move around?
4. What basic principles for all Christians are found in the sending out of the Twelve? (vs. 1-6, Matt. 28:18-20, 2 Cor. 5:19b-20)
5. What critical issue for all Christian ministry and faith was demonstrated by Herod? (vs. 7-9, 23:7-11, Matt. 14:1-2, John 8:24, 14:6)
6. Read Luke 9:10-17, Mark 6:30-31. What happened when the disciples returned from their missionary journey?
7. What can be learned about Jesus by his response to the crowd? (Matt. 14:14-16)
8. How do you respond to others when their needs interrupt your plans?
9. Why did Jesus tell his disciples to feed the crowd when he knew it was impossible for them to do so?
10. List the lessons that you learned from this miracle of “Feeding the Five Thousand.”
