Luke 9:37-62

1. Read Luke 9:37-42. If the disciples had been given power and authority (v. 1), why were they unable to heal the boy? (Also use the parallel accounts in Matt. 17:14-20 and Mark 9:14-29 for the answer.) Why did Jesus have such strong words for his disciples?
  
2. Why do we at times fail to live a powerful, victorious Christ life? Could Christ rightly be disappointed with us? Why? (See also Romans 6:5-7, 11-19)
  
3. Read Luke 9:43-45. Why do you think Jesus warned his disciples at this time about his future betrayal?
  
4. Verses 46-55 record three different situations where Jesus had to correct the wrong thinking of his disciples. How were they “off-track” and what lesson did he teach them in each case?
