Exodus 3:1-4:17

1. Read Exodus 3:1-10. *The Call of Moses*: As chapter 3 begins, where was Moses? What was he doing? Who appeared to him? How?
2. What does God reveal about himself in vv.4-6? How did Moses respond? Why did the Lord say he came down? (vv. 7-10)
3. Read Exodus 3:11-22. *The Objections of Moses*: What key questions does Moses ask in the following verses and what was God's reply?

4. What was Moses told to do in vs. 16-17? How would the elders respond? (v. 18a)
5. What were Moses and the elders to do in vs. 18b-19? How would the king of Egypt respond?
6. What did God promise to do in response?
7. Read Exodus 4:1-17. Moses is still a most reluctant servant. What objections did he raise in the following verses and how did God answer him?
