Lesson 8  
Luke 4:31-44

1. Read Luke 4:31-37. What did the people in Capernaum recognize about Jesus' words that the Nazarenes had missed? (See also Matt. 7:28-29)
2. What does it mean that "his message had authority"? When you speak about Jesus or your faith in him, do your words have authority? Why or why not?
3. What greater knowledge of Jesus did the demons have? (vv. 34, 41, and James 2:19) Why did he order them to be silent?
4. Read Luke 4:38-44. What was wrong with Simon's mother-in-law? How did Jesus heal her? What evidence is given of her complete physical healing?
5. Why did so many people come to him after sunset? Who were they? Who did they bring to Jesus?
6. What was the overall purpose of this healing ministry?
7. Obviously this was a busy and demanding time for Jesus. Why did he get up early and go to a solitary place? (see also Mark 1:35) What should we learn from this example?
8. How did the people in Capernaum respond in a totally opposite way than those in Nazareth? What was Jesus' answer to them?
9. As a Christian, do you share somewhat the same urgency and call upon your life? (Consider Matthew 28:18-20, Acts 1:7-8, Romans 10:12-17, 1 Cor. 9:16-19) Who told you about Jesus? Who might not hear if you do not tell them?
