Lesson 17
Luke 9:18-36

1. Read Luke 9:18-20 and Matt. 16:16. Who did the crowds think Jesus was? Who did Peter say that He was?
2. Who do you say Jesus is? Carefully think through your answer and write it out.
3. Read Luke 9:21-22 and Matt. 16:21-23. What was missing from the Jewish view of their Messiah? How does this help explain Luke 9:21 and 36?
4. Read Luke 9:23-27. We often think of “bearing our cross” as putting up with a difficult person or situation, but it is more than that. What does it mean to deny yourself and take up your cross daily?
5. Read Luke 9:27-36 along with 2 Peter 1:16-18. Considering the context in which it is given, how would you explain verse 27?
6. Read Luke 9:29, Matt. 17:2 and Mark 9:2-3. How is Jesus described? What were the disciples seeing?
7. Who also appeared on the Mount of Transfiguration? What was wrong with Peter’s thinking?
8. What were the purposes of the Transfiguration?
9. What did the “voice coming from the cloud say”? What should be our response?
10. Read Romans 12:1-2 and 2 Cor. 3:18. How can we experience our own spiritual “transfiguration/transformation”?
