Lesson 4
Joel 2:18-32

1. Read Joel 2:18 and Exodus 34:10-14. What does it mean for the LORD to be jealous? Can His jealousy be a good thing? How? (For further study read Isaiah 45:18-25.)
2. Read Joel 2:19-27 and list all that the LORD promises to do for them. Look for the “I” statements.
3. Compare this section to chapter 1. What promises in this section reverse or restore what was previously taken from the people?
4. Verses 21-23 have the only commands given to the hearers in this section. What commands are given? What reasons does he give for the hearers to do this?
5. Read Joel 2:28-31. What does the LORD promise to do in the future for His people? Who will be included in receiving this gift? Why does he list these specific groups of people?
6. We will discuss these in greater depth next week, but please read Luke 24:40-52 and Acts 2:1-41. Write down any questions or observations you have after reading these texts.
7. Read Joel 2:32. What promise concludes this section? How is this reassuring to hearers in Joel’s day? How is this reassuring to us?
